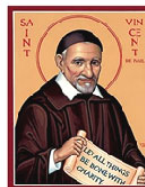

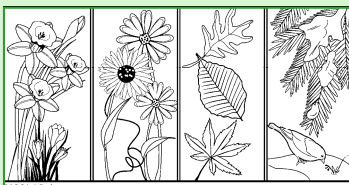

### Catechism Corner

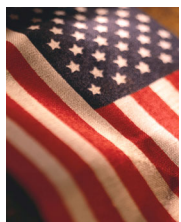
#### 576. Is it possible to pray always?

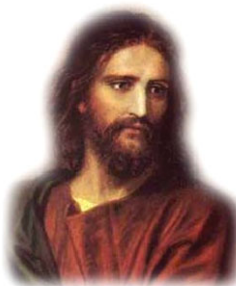
